Just a reminder, the Credit Union will be CLOSED Thanksgiving Day and the day after Thanksgiving, Friday, Nov. 29<sup>th</sup>. If

you have direct deposit, your payroll will get posted on November 29<sup>th</sup> and the funds will be available on your Visa Check Card. All other postings and updates will still occur in the morning. Please note our hours on Wednesday, November 27<sup>th</sup>, will be extended 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Please plan your Thanksgiving spending ahead of time!

Our hours will be 9:00a.m. until Noon on Tuesday, December 24<sup>th</sup>. We will be closed on Wednesday, December 25<sup>th</sup> for Christmas. We will be open Thursday, December 26<sup>th</sup> from 8:00am to 4:00pm.



For New Year's Eve, Tuesday, Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>, our hours will be 9:00a.m. until Noon. We will be closed on Wednesday, January 1<sup>st</sup> on New Year's Day. We will

be open Thursday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, from 8:00am to 4:00pm.

# CAUTION

As the ease of online shopping increases, so does the chance of encountering online fraud. It is important to protect yourself and your debit card from online scammers.

Please be vigilant when using your debit card to make purchases online. Ask yourself a few questions before giving any of your information. Is it a reputable and well-known website? Is it a secure website? Am I shopping from a link clicked in a social media ad or phishing email? Is the price for this item too good to be true? Am I signing up for a free trial that I will need to cancel? Is there merchant contact information in case I have a problem?

Look for HTTPS (not HTTP) and a padlock symbol near the URL in the web browser's address bar. Use official shopping apps whenever possible and keep apps updated. Pay special attention to any product sold by other retailers ("marketplace sellers") that is not coming from an official online store like *Amazon* or *Best Buy*, for example. Do not store your payment details with an online store. Avoid paying for items with nontraditional payment methods like a wire transfer, gift cards, money orders, or payment apps (Venmo, CashApp, Zelle, etc). When shopping online, use a secure internet connection versus a public wi-fi network. Regularly monitor your banking transactions.

By being a careful consumer, you will avoid the inconvenience of having your debit card blocked due to fraud and having unauthorized charges on your account which you may or may not have rights to dispute.
